Cranna Announces Re-Election Bid

Tivoli... Village of Tivoli Deputy Mayor, Bryan F. Cranna has announced today that he will seek a third term to the Village of Tivoli Board of Trustees. Election Day is March 18th.

Cranna was first elected in 2004, and was named Deputy Mayor in January of 2007 by Mayor Thomas Cordier.
